In particular, it gives the highlights of the progress in Management Information System (MIS), Web Management, and Network Expansion. Setting up an “IT Helpdesk” at the Centre in the beginning of the year, which became fully functional in April 2008, has been a unique experiment of its kind to facilitate the users of the central IT facilities throughout the University. A brief information on the functioning of the Helpdesk is given in this newsletter.

The FTK-CIT has hosted a number of servers for various Intranet applications. Many users are already aware of the facilities offered and are already using them. For sharing the information with the entire Jamia community, we have included in this issue URLs of useful Internet and Intranet sites. It is quite possible that some of the departments of the University or their faculty members might have set up their own servers or developed some useful sites which could be useful to others. Similarly, most of the faculties, centres and departments of studies have their own computer centres/labs and they are engaged in various ICT activities. We would like to invite them to send such information for their publication in the forthcoming issues of the CIT Updates for the benefit of other IT users in the University.

The total number of participants in the Programme was twenty-three. In these trainings, the participants also had practical hands-on sessions on Demo MIS database.

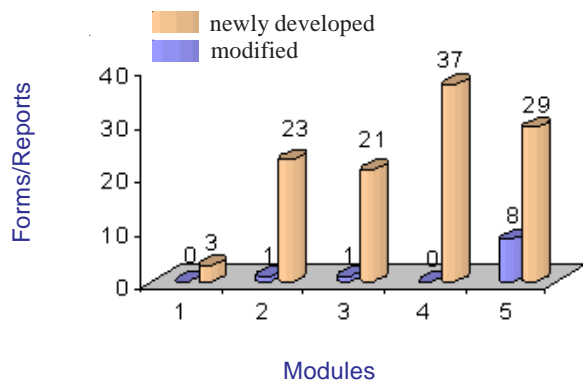
Progress in MIS

In this Quarter

- ◆ MIS Database Size increased to 30.5 GB.
- ◆ Admission results of 44 courses were generated through MIS.
- ◆ The Finance Module was modified for MCRC and implemented in April 2008.
- ◆ Pensioners’/Family Pensioners’ ID Cards developed using MIS and handed over to the Establishment Section of the Registrars’ Office for implementation.
- ◆ MIS-based Students’ ID Cards were modified, both for the University Sector and the School Sector.

During the 2nd quarter of 2008, 10 new Forms/Reports were developed for three existing MIS modules. In contrast, 113 existing Forms/Reports of five modules were modified.

MIS Fellowship Module

A separate sub-Module has been added into the Student Module of the MIS System for the management of various fellowships being availed by the students of the university. The System contains detailed information regarding the fellowships, the sanctioning authority, total sanctioned amount as well as the details of payments made against the receipts. Therefore, the accounting of the fellowship along with the opening and closing balance is available at a click of the mouse.

A separate Module for the Hostel Management System has been added into the MIS which contains complete information regarding various hostels, total number of seats available in each hostel, number of vacant/occupied seats in each hostel room, and details about the students residing in the hostels. The system also maintains information regarding monthly mess charges as well as mess charges deposited by a student. Furthermore, it provides information regarding contractor's bills.

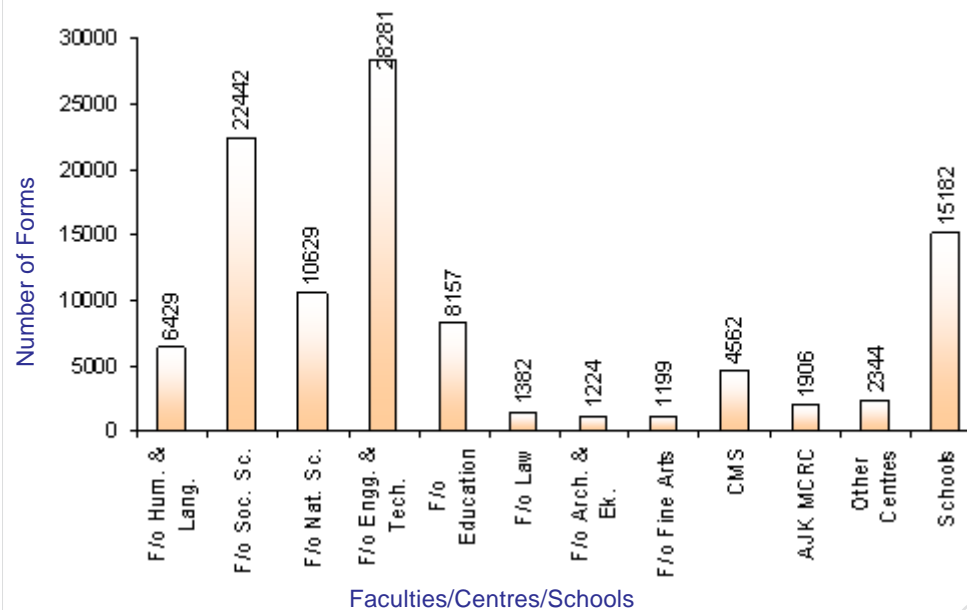

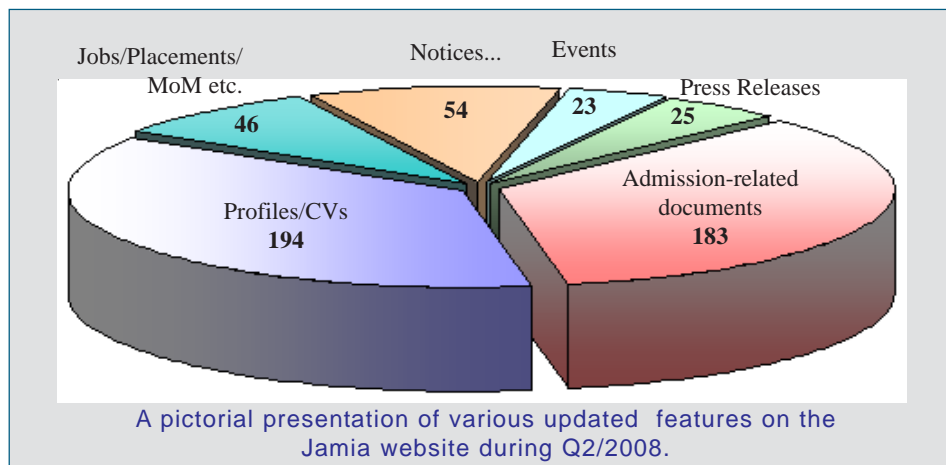

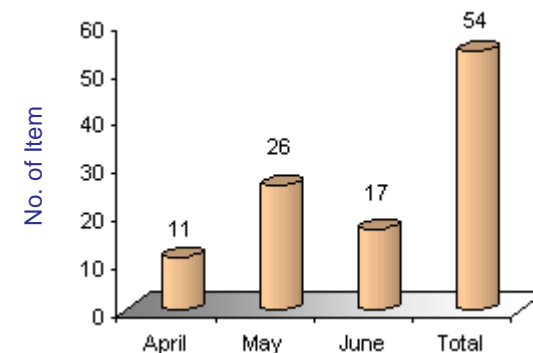

The following graph gives a statistics about the number of pages updated on the Jamia website in the 2nd quarter of 2008:



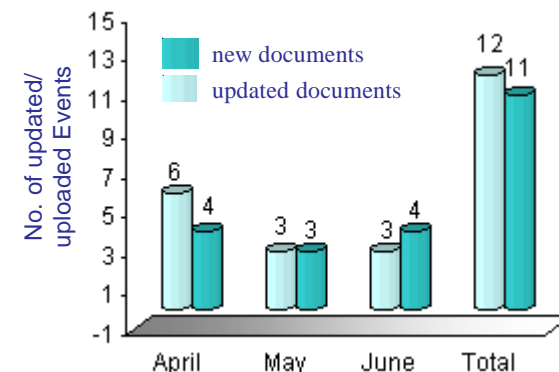
Notices and Office Orders

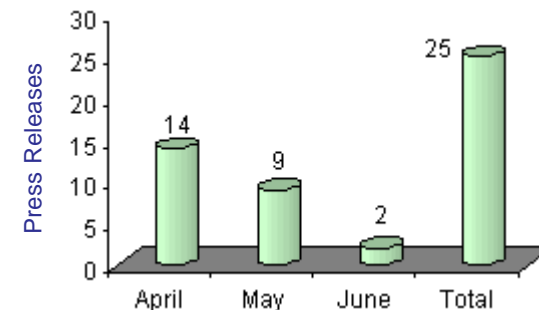
Events and Conferences

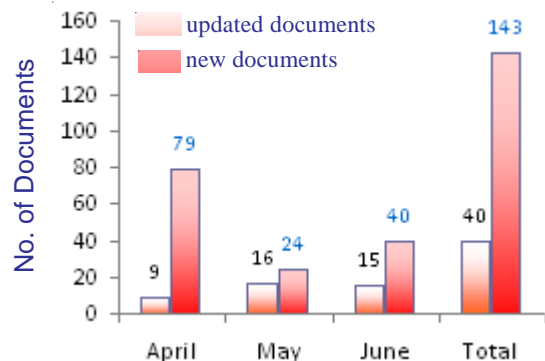
During the 2nd quarter of 2008, 25 Press Releases, received from the Office of the Media Coordinator, were uploaded on the Jamia website





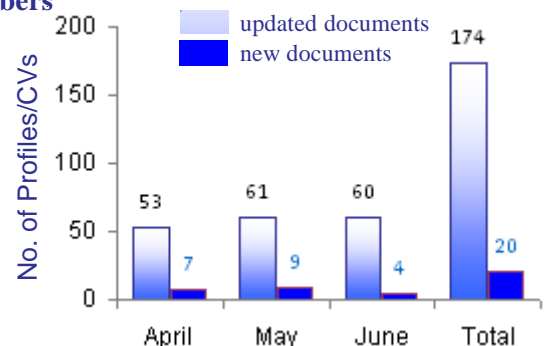
Admission-related Documents

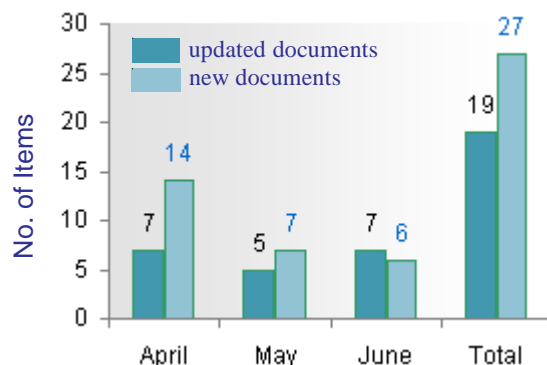
Profiles/CVs related to Departments/Centres and their Faculty Members

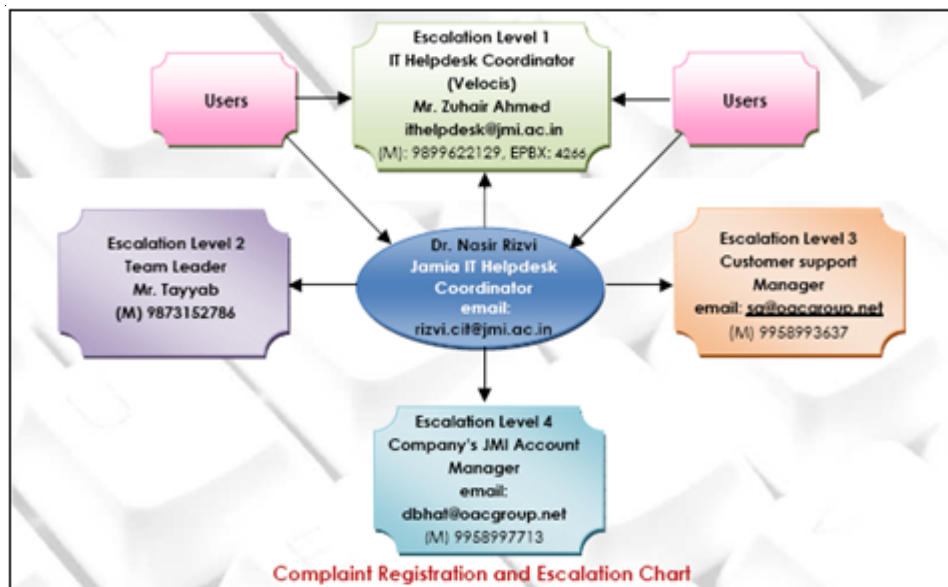
IT Helpdesk Services

To facilitate the computer and Internet users in the University and to address their IT-related problems, a centralized IT Helpdesk facility has been setup at the FTK-Centre for Information Technology. The Support is being provided through M/Velocis Systems Pvt. Ltd. who have been awarded the Annual Maintenance Contract by Jamia Millia Islamia.

They are responsible for the following IT-related problems:

- ◆ Maintenance of Computers, Printers, UPS and other peripherals under AMC.
- ◆ Installation of Operating Systems & Antivirus Software and resolving virus related problems.
- ◆ MIS Installation.
- ◆ Network related problems and Internet connectivity.
- ◆ Maintenance of the Passive Network.

The users may lodge their complaints with the IT Helpdesk Coordinator. The complaints may also be registered through E-Mail with a copy to Dr. Syed Nasir Aziz Rizvi, Jamia IT Helpdesk Coordinator.

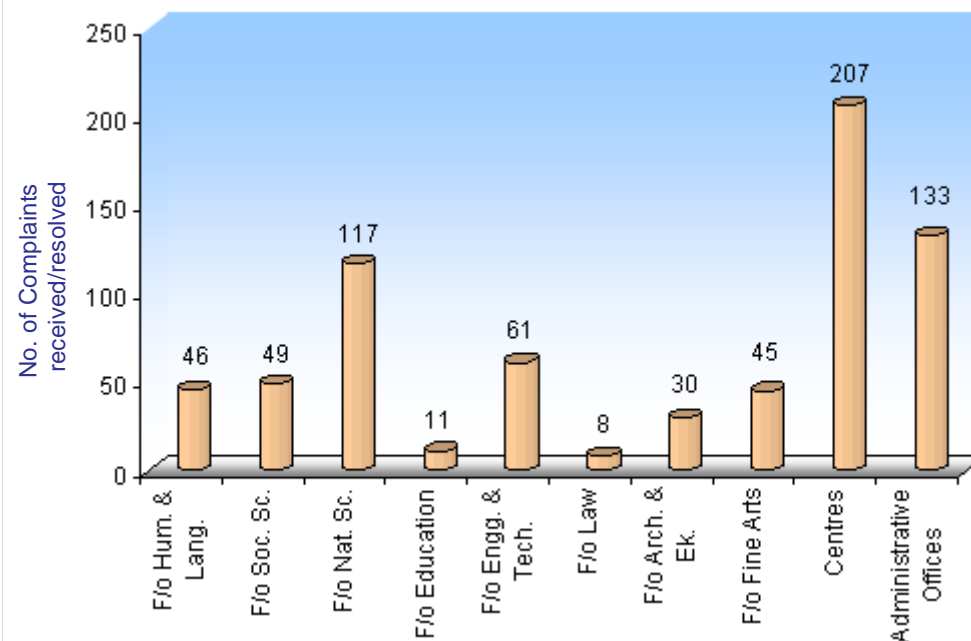


In case of telephonic complaints, the IT Helpdesk Coordinator will issue a Complaint ID to the complaints. The users are requested to always cite complaint IDs while reporting their problems to team leader and higher officials of the Helpdesk team in case the problem are not solved with reasonable time.
