## Event Report World Tourism Day-2022 September 27, 2022



The Department of Tourism and Hospitality Management (DTHM), Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI), New Delhi observed World Tourism Day-2022 on September 27, 2022. World Tourism Day is commemorated each year on 27 September to foster awareness among the international community of the importance of tourism and its social, cultural, political and economic value. This year the theme of WTD-2022 is “Rethinking Tourism”.

The event unfolded on 27th September by organizing theme related activities and competitions in the Department in which students from various faculties and Departments took active participation. DTHM organized Videography Contest on the theme of World Tourism Day. The students enthusiastically exhibited their videography skills in the competition. To mark the celebrations of World Tourism Day 2022, the students of the department had also put up sumptuous food, mocktails, merchandise stalls.

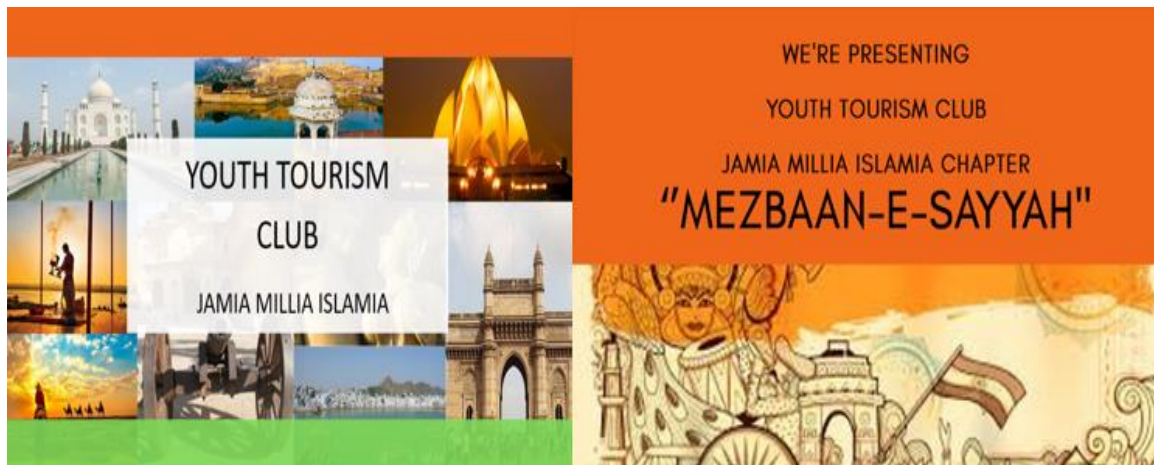
