In 2009 the Centre for Distance and Open Learning was approved by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India. All UG and PG Programmes of the Centre for Distance & Open Learning, JMI have UGC-DEB recognition and NCTE approval. Presently there are twenty programmes (Post-Graduate, Under-Graduate, PG Diploma, Diploma and Certificate) being run at the CDOL and its Learner Support Centres located across India.

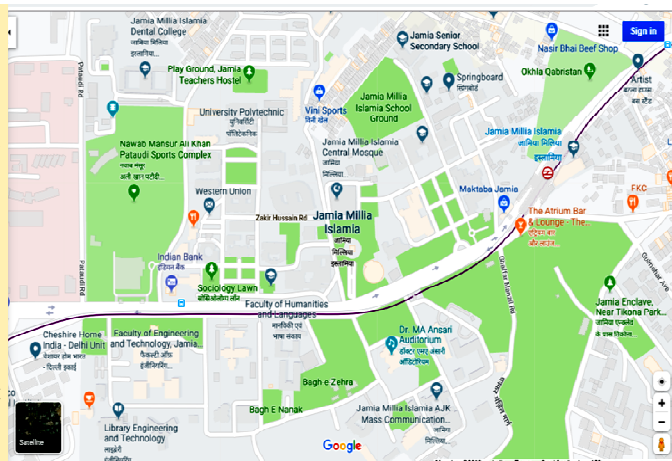
VENUE

The conference will be organized at the Jamia Millia Islamia campus.
