He read, researched, and taught modern Indian and world history in various colleges of Delhi University before joining the CSDS's Sarai programme at its inception in 2000. Ravikant's collaboratively edited books include *Translating Partition: Stories, Essays, Criticism* with Tarun Saint (2001); *Deewan e Sarai 01: Media Vimarsh: Hindi Janpad* (2002), *Deewan e Sarai 02: Shaharnama* with Sanjay Sharma (2005); His collaborative filmography includes Andaz Production's *Kali Shalwar* (2001), an adaptation of Saadat Hasan Manto's eponymous story, and *Jo Dooba So Paar* (2011).
