

Report of Orientation Programme for B.A (Hons) Economics 3rd and 5th Semesters, JMI

An orientation programme was organised by the Department of Economics Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi for continuing classes of 3rd and 5th semester Economics Honours on 22/7 /2019. The venue of the programme was room no. 207 SSB (Old Commerce Building). There was overwhelming response from the students. More than 60 students belonging to 3rd and 5th semesters and faculty members of the Department graced the occasion.

The event started at 11. 30 am with welcome address by Dr Asheref Illiyan, Associate Professor and coordinator, BA (Hons) Economics Programme. At the outset he extended a warm welcome to all the students for the new academic session 2019-20. He appraised them of necessity of punctuality in the class room for smooth and continued teaching learning process and exhorted them the importance of hard work for success in life. Dr Asheref pointed out that this year is crucial year for the final year students as they have to clear this year's papers and prepare for multiple entrance examinations to be held in various centres of excellence such as JNU, DU, IGIDR, Madras School of Economics, Gokale Institute etc. He assured them that through continued hard work and dedication any goal can be achieved easily. He familiarised the students with core, optional and CBCS papers.

Professor Halima Sadia Rizvi , Head of the Department delivered key note speech in the event. She welcomed students to the new academic session and assured them all sorts of support for their fruitful stay in the Department.

At the outset she motivated the students by pointing out the improved ranking of the university year by year by various national and international agencies and selection of 47 students for IAS, IPS and other allied services by UPSC from Residential Coaching Academy, JMI and recent passing of 102 students in the UPSC civil services preliminary examination. She exhorted them how fortunate they are to be one of the few selected candidates out of the 21000 applicants for BA (Hons) Economics, BBA and BCom in Jamia and to be part of centenary celebration of JMI. Dr Halima also showcased the success stories of the department by informing the students that 25 students from final year have qualified UGC NET and 3 students JRF and also another 6 students got campus placement in reputed national and international companies with highest salary packages.

For a inclusive society she talked about need for gender sensitisation in the campus and need to respect girls students. The students were also informed of the grievance redressal mechanism at department and university level.
