



Joan Maria Thomàs (Palma de Mallorca, 1953), has taught at various Spanish and foreign universities (China, Australia, New Delhi, London, Wisconsin) and is author, among many other works, of *La Falange de Franco* (2001); *Feixistes! viatge a l'interior del falangisme català* (2008); *Roosevelt and Franco: From the Spanish Civil War to Pearl Harbor* (New York, 2008); *La Batalla del Wolframi. Estats Units i Espanya de Pearl Harbor als inicis de la Guerra Freda 1941-1947* (2010); *Roosevelt, Franco and the End of World War II* (New York, 2011); *Els Feixismes espanyols* (2011). Considered an expert on Falange, Spanish Civil War, Francoism and US-Spain relations, he has been nominated by the Royal Academy of History (Spain) as the academico correspondiente.
