Course Description

The coursework will impart a general introduction to postmedia studies through the various theoretical deliberations on technology. The paradigmatic shift opened up by the differing constitution of computation has transformed the role of communication in the present world and subsequently reconfigured the notion of human subjectivity. This particular conjecture raises relevant concerns regarding technics and time, questioning the linear history of technological evolution by so-called vectors of deterritorialization and ruptures in temporalization. This crisis calls for a critical and urgent reappraisal of technicity in what Joff Bradley has called the petrification of the now. This three-week course at the Centre for Culture, Media and Governance will critically investigate contemporary postmedia practices from the perspective of Deleuze and Guattari.
