8(i)	<p>A candidate enrolled in the Ph.D. course will be required to submit his/her thesis not earlier than two years but not later than five years. Provided that the Board of Studies/ Committee of Studies, after the expiry of five years period, may grant an extension for a period of one year on the recommendations of the Supervisor concerned. If the candidate fails to submit his/ her Ph.D. Thesis within the extended period of one year, an extension of another year may be granted by the Vice – Chancellor on the basis of the recommendation of the Board of Studies/ Committee of Studies.</p>	<p>A candidate enrolled in the Ph.D. course will be required to submit his/her thesis not earlier than two years but not later than five years. Provided that the Board of Studies/ Committee of Studies, after the expiry of the five year period, may grant an extension for a period of one year on the recommendations of the Supervisor concerned. 8(viii)	<p>Every Ph. D. student shall give a Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar at least six months before the submission of the thesis. Provided that the Head/ Dean/ Director of the Department/ Faculty/ Centre concerned shall make the arrangements for the above presentation.</p> <p>The Supervisor/ Co – Supervisor of the said candidate shall ensure that the candidate include the suggestion made during the Seminar presentation in his/ her thesis before is finally submitted.</p>	<p>Every Ph. D. student shall give a Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar at least six months before the submission of the thesis. Provided that the Head/ Dean/ Director of the Department/ Faculty/ Centre concerned shall make the arrangements for the above presentation.</p> <p>The Supervisor/ Co – Supervisor of the said candidate shall ensure that the candidate include(s) the suggestion(s) made during the Seminar presentation in his/ her thesis before it is finally submitted.</p> <p>For the purpose of clarity, it is hereby provided that,</p> <p>The thesis may be submitted even before the expiry of six months period from the date of Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar provided that the Supervisor/Co-</p>

		<p>Supervisor ensures that the quality of students' thesis merits submission.</p> <p>The candidate may submit his/her thesis even beyond the expiry of six months since the date of Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar with the approval of the Supervisor/Co-Supervisor and the Head/Dean/Director concerned. However, the maximum period granted to the candidate shall not exceed twelve (12) months from the date of Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar.</p> <p>In case the candidate is not able to submit his/her thesis within the twelve (12) month period, he/she shall be required to make a fresh Pre-Ph.D. Submission Seminar.</p>
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
