MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is executed on this 18th July 2008 at New Delhi.

BETWEEN

JAMIA MILLIA ISLAMIA, New Delhi a Central University created by an Act of Parliament of India (i.e. Jamia Millia Islamia Act, 1988) and is a body corporate with a perpetual succession and a common seal (acting through its Registrar presently Mr. S.M. Afzal, IPS, as its authorized signatory) (hereinafter referred as JMI').

AND

DIRECTOR GENERAL, ESI Corporation, Ministry of Labour, Government of India, New Delhi through Dr. J.P. Bhasne, Medical Commissioner and its authorized signatory (hereinafter referred ESIC).

WHEREAS, it is the statutory objects of the JMI to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional research and extension facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit and it shall endeavor to provide to students and teachers the necessary atmosphere and facilities for the promotion of:

 innovations in education leading to restructuring of courses, new methods of teaching and learning and integral development of personality.

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- (ii) studies in various disciplines,
- (iii) inter disciplinary studies,
- (iv) national integration, secularism and international understanding

AND WHEREAS the 250 bed General Hospital of ESIC at Okhla, Phase-I, New Delhi is a hospital with excellent facilities in management and treatment of various diseases.

AND WHEREAS, the JMI has established a Faculty of Dentistry which would inter alia offer Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) Course after completion of due formalities and procedures.

AND WHEREAS, for the purposes of clinical training of its students, Jamia Millia Islamia has chosen ESIC Hospital, Okhla, Phase- I as Centre for imparting the clinical and practical training to its BDS students at ESIC Hospital in the disciplines of Medicine, Surgery and other related subjects.

AND WHEREAS, for the purpose of synergistically combining the strengths of two organizations for mutual interest in the field of academic matters. ESIC has agreed to allow the dental students of JMI to pursue their training on the terms and conditions as here to agreed upon by and between the two parties.

NOW THEREFORE the JMI and ESIC intended, agreed and consented to the following terms and deeds in pursuance of a common intent to promote and develop the study of dentistry.

FIELD OF CO-OPERATION:

Both JMI and ESIC shall consent to the following terms & conditions:-

- a) ESIC 250 bedded General Hospital, Okhla, Phase-I, New Delhi shall allow coordinated access to the staff and students of JMI for the purposes of clinical training in the area of Medicines, Surgery and allied subjects for a period of five years w.e.f. date of actual utilization of facilities or till their own hospital is commissioned.
- b) The license to access by ESIC would be inclusive of utilization of facilities, interaction with medical and para-medical staff, understanding patients and disease by JMI students.
- c) JMI shall be liable to pay a sum of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) for each registered student on an annual basis for services rendered by ESIC as agreed to in clauses (a) & (b) hereinabove with effect from the date facilities are commenced for utilization.
- d) JMI will provide all necessary assistance regarding Faculty and other academic support for establishment of Dental Colleges in ESIC Hospital.

- e) JMI shall be responsible for any loss or damages to the properties belonging to ESIC caused by the students or staff of JMI.
- f) The JMI acknowledges that any breach during the training period by its staff or students could result in significant losses or damages to ESIC. Jamia Millia Islamia agrees to indemnify ESIC in respect of all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, losses and damages which ESI may suffer or incur, or which may be brought against ESIC as a result or in any way arising out of any breach by the staff and students of JMI.

2. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a) The details for the efficacious implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.
- b) The parities to this Memorandum may, by mutual consent, add modify, amend, delete review or revise any term(s) and condition(s) of this Memorandum.
- c) Without prejudice to the generality of the co-operation as incorporated in this MOU, the parties herein may sign collaborative agreements in other fields of common interest.
- d) Disputes, if any, arising out of this Memorandum of intent and /or its enforcement shall be referred to arbitration under the Arbitration & Conciliation Act. 1996.
