MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MOU is made by and between Centre for DNA Fingerprinting and Diagnostics (CDFD), an Autonomous Institute of DBT, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India having its office at Nacharam, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh. acting through its Director Shri Dr. Scyed E Hasnain (hereinafter referred as "CDFD")

AND

Jamia Millia Islamia, a Central University, by an Act of Parliament having its headquarters at Jamia Nagar, New Delhi (herein after referred as "JMI")

RECOGNISING the mutual interests and benefits of a collaboration for the promotion of Bioinformatics teaching and research the Centre for DNA Fingerprinting and Diagnostics (CDFD) and Jamil Millia Islamia, have reached an understanding among themselves on the activities set forth hereunder :

1. The JMI, shall send 2 or 3 students of PGDBIN/M.Sc (Bioinformatics) of its department of Computer science (final semester) to carry out a comprehensive project of 4-6 months duration at CDFD. The said students will be provided boarding and lodging in the CDFD hostel. The expenses of those visits shall not be borne out by the CDFD.
2. The research scholars/research staff of CDFD may register at JMI for Ph.D programmes. Faculty members of Department of Computer Science or Department of Biosciences, Jamia Millia Islamia, will act as supervisor(s) and scientist(s) from CDFD will act as co-supervisor(s) as per JMI rules.

3. The Department of Computer Science may invite scientists from CDFD for extension lectures ranging from 4 days to a week in the department. The expenses incurred on such visits would be borne by JMI.
4. Annual one week lab oriented training on "Computational Genomics", "Homology Modelling" etc., would be conducted by CDFD for the students of PGDBIN/M.Sc (Bioinformatics) course of JMI. The students would proceed in two batches to CDFD which will provide them boarding/lodging facility. The expenses of those visits shall not be borne out by the CDFD.
5. Short visits to CDFD may be made by the faculty members of the department of Computer Science to get acquainted with the ongoing research in Bioinformatics.
6. For further regulation and implementation of the details of this MoU, both the parties herein or their respective delegates shall mutually settle the said conditions.
7. This MOU may be terminated by either side by six months notice.
8. The terms of MoU may be further supplemented, added, modified, revised, deleted and /or curtailed by express mutual consent of both the parties herein.


