 - (iii) Those students who have neither appeared in pre-board nor in the Unit Tests, their performance will be assessed based on their performance in the final examination of the IX Class.
- O2. As regards Class XII, the Committee decided that decision in respect of preparation of the result of Class XII be taken after notification of such guidelines from the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).
- 03. The Committee decided that classes X & XII private examination will be held only after the present situation becomes somewhat normal.
