



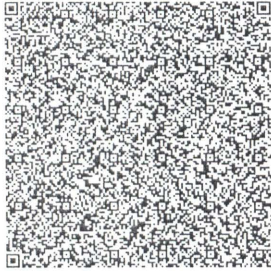

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THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IS SIGNED BETWEEN:

Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI), a **Central University** under an enactment of the Parliament of India (i.e. the Jamia Millia Islamia Act, 1988) and is a body corporate with a perpetual succession and a common seal (acting through its Registrar)

AND

The Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (CCRUM) an apex research organization for research and development of Unani Medicine under the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India. The Council was established with a view to aid, develop, conduct and coordinate multifaceted research activities in the field of Unani Medicine. The Council's **Central Research Institute of Unani Medicine (CRIUM)** located at Hyderabad is inter alia engaged in multifaceted research in various disciplines of Unani Medicine and as a Research Unit of CCRUM is responsible to carry out other activities in furtherance of the cause of promotion of Unani Medicine.

AND WHEREAS it is the statutory object of the JMI to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional, research and extension facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit and it shall endeavor to provide to students and teachers the necessary atmosphere and facilities for the promotion of:

- (i) Innovations in education leading to restructuring of courses, new methods of teaching and learning.
- (ii) Studies in various disciplines
- (iii) Inter disciplinary/ allied studies.
- (iv) National integration, secularism and international understanding.

NOW THEREFORE JMI and CCRUM have intended, agreed and consented to **following terms and deeds** in pursuance of a common intent to promote and develop the study of MD, Ph.D in Unani Medicine at Central Research Institute of Unani Medicine (CRIUM), Hyderabad under the aegis of **Faculty of Natural Sciences**, JMI.

1. FIELD OF COOPERATION:

Following Ministry of Ayush, Government of India's endorsement to foster research in indigenous systems of medicines the CCRUM submitted a proposal to start M.D. and Ph.D programmes in specialties of Moalajat (General Medicine) and Ilmul Advia (Pharmacology) at Central Research Institute of Unani Medicine, Hyderabad in collaboration with Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi.



- (a) JMI through this MoU shall collaborate with CCRUM's Central Research Institute of Unani Medicine, Hyderabad for starting M.D. Unani and Ph.D programmes in following specialties' from current academic year i.e. 2016-2017.

M.D and Ph.D in other specialties would also be offered in the subsequent years.

- (b) The CCRUM through CRIUM, Hyderabad shall provide all necessary facilities in respect of infrastructure such as Hospitals, Laboratories and other resources to run the programme.
- (c) Jamia Millia Islamia shall conduct entrance test for admission to MD (Unani) and Ph.D (Unani) programmes besides interview for the Ph.D programme. Counseling/Interview of the candidates will be conducted by JMI through a Committee which will have representations from CRIUM for which all expenses would be borne by the CCRUM. The expenditure towards holding meetings for Unani Research Advisory Committee (URAC), Unani Academic Advisory Committee (UAAC) and Board of Studies (Unani Medicine) shall be borne by CCRUM.
- (d) JMI shall conduct examination in consonance with the regulations of Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM) and JMI besides broader framework and guidelines of Ministry of AYUSH and shall award the degrees accordingly.
- (e) The place of work for each selected candidate for Ph.D programme will be decided as per the topic selected by the candidates and availability of infrastructural facilities. However, the M.D programme will be managed between JMI and CRIUM.
- (f) There will be a supervisor from JMI and a co-supervisor from CRIUM. However, on the recommendation of the BoS, an additional co-supervisor can be provisioned whenever necessary. Allocation of supervisors will be in accordance with JMI ordinances.
- (g) The Board of Studies (Unani Medicine) under the Department of Biotechnology constituted for the specific purpose (entrusted with the



responsibility of executing the M.D/Ph.D. (Unani) programme on behalf of the Faculty of Natural Sciences) will operationalize these programmes at JMI and CRIUM, Hyderabad. Experts of Unani Medicine from across the country will be co-opted members of the BoS.

- (h) A Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) will be created to oversee the academic, financial and administrative implementation of the MoU.
- (i) The CCRUM will enable JMI to develop infrastructure for Unani Courses in the university for which it shall arrange funds from governmental and non-governmental agencies.
- (j) The CCRUM will also help set up Hakim Ajmal Khan Chair in JMI to promote Unani Studies and Research.
- (k) The CCRUM will also consider commencement of foundation courses such as Pharmacy, Bachelor in Unani Medicine and other allied disciplines for promotion of Unani System of Medicine.
- (l) The fee structure for the M.D (Unani) and Ph.D (Unani) would be at par with that of National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bengaluru or as mutually determined by the partnering institutions.
- (m) The CCRUM and JMI have constituted the Academic and Research Advisory Committees which will aid, advice and monitor the progress and outcome of the above programmes at regular intervals.

2. MISCELLANEOUS:

- (a) The parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall have no legal binding. Nothing mentioned in this Memorandum of Understanding shall deem to constitute partnership between the signing parties appointing one party as an agent of the other.
- (b) The details for the efficacious implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the parties.
- (c) The parties to this Memorandum of Understanding may, by mutual consent, add modify, amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition (s) of this Agreement. Provided that, no such addition, modification, amendment, deletion, review or revision shall be effective unless made in writing and signed by each party's representative.
- (d) The Financial arrangements involved in the implementation of this of Understanding shall be settled through consultation between the two institutions in respect of each program of cooperation.
- (e) This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for period of 5 years from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a six months Notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the Notice of the intent to terminate the Memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties flowing and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof. In the event of termination of the MoU the candidates registered will be taken care of by both the parties in respect of academic and financial obligations till completion of the programme and award of degree.
- (f) The parties may renew the Memorandum of Understanding on mutually acceptable terms prior to its termination. The process of renewing the Memorandum of Understanding can be taken up six months before its expiry through mutual agreement.
- (g) The parties to this memorandum of Understanding undertake to treat as "**confidential and privileged**" information of the other institution which is so classified in advance. The terms of Confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.



- (h) This Memorandum of Undertaking shall require the ratification of the competent Academic/ Executive body of JMI and the concerned Academic / Executive body of CCRUM.
- (i) Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Memorandum of Undertaking shall be governed by and construed solely in accordance with the laws of India, without regard to the conflicts of law provisions thereof, and the courts at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction in this regard.
