

## **SYLLABUS FOR DIPLOMA IN TURKISH (ONE-YEAR COURSE)**

In addition to the revision of certificate course syllabus, the main emphasis will be on reading, writing, speaking and listening abilities of students by using Turkish in a wide variety of situations such as; meeting with friends or new persons; self introduction, introducing the family members or the other persons; ordering a menu, asking the price; asking the phone numbers; giving information about the work life and schedule, informing about the daily life (summarizing a typical day); asking and informing about dates and times; telling about the hobbies, likes and dislikes; describing the parts of a home and the objects in the rooms; describing the city (the important and famous places); asking the addresses; talking about the abilities, talents and skills.

Students will practice to translate the texts from Turkish into English and from English to Turkish. Practice in spoken Turkish.
